About the Club

The South Bay Chinese Club was formed on November 19, 1965 to preserve the culture and customs of the Chinese heritage, to foster and encourage better understanding of civic responsibilities and the American way of life, and to promote the general welfare of the community.

In 1984, the Club formed the South Bay Chinese Service Club, a California non-profit organization. The Service Club was formed to provide state and federal tax-exempt status in its pursuit of community service activities, such as the Scholarship Program. Members of the South Bay Chinese Club are also members of the Service Club.

One of the most worthwhile activities that the Club sponsors is the annual Scholarship Program. This program began in 1970 by providing two scholarships of \$100 each to graduating high school seniors of Chinese descent. In 2022 the Scholarship Program provided \$41,000 in scholarship money. The scholarships are presented at the annual scholarship awards banquet where all recipients, as the club's guests, are addressed by a keynote speaker.
